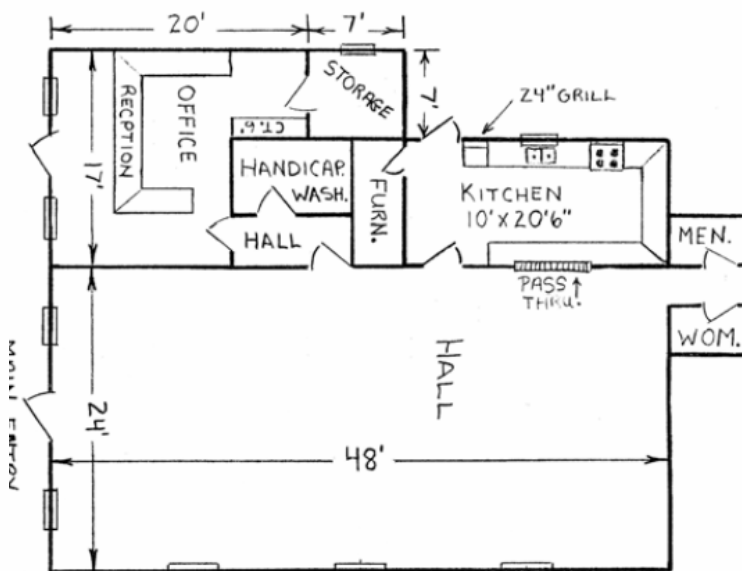
Amenities
